

Existing nutritional opportunities

- In households that did or didn't feed legumes :
- Feeding legumes had 42% **lower** mortality rate in SRs
- Statistically, the practice of not feeding leguminous feeds accounted for 25% of the mortality observed
 - i.e., it was a large risk factor for SR mortality



Summary

- Farmers confirm feeding quality and quantity is a constraint
- BUT there are major opportunities:
 - At the same time farmers have large variety of feeds they are already using
 - Farmers are used to using many feeds
- Certain feed types already improve production
