INFORMATION ABOUT MANGO PRODUCTION IN SOUTHEAST AND VIETNAM

Mango is growing in many countries in Southeast of Asian and it is a popular fruit in these countries. According to FAO statistics, countries grower more mango tree in Southeast of Asia are Thailand, Indonesia, Philippines, Vietnam and Cambodia.

Thailand is the largest mango producer in Southeast of Asia. Thailand produced 3,432,000 tonnes of mangos, followed by Indonesia (2,184,000 tonnes) Philippine (827 thousand tons), Vietnam (725 thousand tons) in 2016. Cambodia is also a large producer of mangos in Southeast of Asia, with an area of 65,000 hectares of mango in 2017.

Vietnam is a county growing mango for many years and mango is grow in whole county, but mainly in the southern provinces. In 2017, Vietnam has 92,746 hectares and output of 788,233 tons of mango, of which the Mekong Delta was the largest mango producing area, accounting for 46.1% of the area and 64.4% of the mango production of the country; followed by the South East (accounting for 19.2% of the total area and 64.4% of the total mango production).

In the Mekong Delta region of Vietnam, Dong Thap province has the largest area and output of mangos, accounting for 21.4% of the area and 28.5% of the mango production in the whole region (Table 2).

There are many varieties of mango in Vietnam, in the Mekong Delta, Hoa loc mango and cat chu mango are two delicious mango varieties and they are popular consumers and they are now growing in Tien Giang and Dong Thap province. The drawback of these mango varieties is that mango fruit is hard to bear, especially for Hoa Loc mango and in rainy season of mango production. On the other hand, due to the thin shell, transportation and preservation of Hoa Loc mango and cat chu mango have limited obstacles to export.
